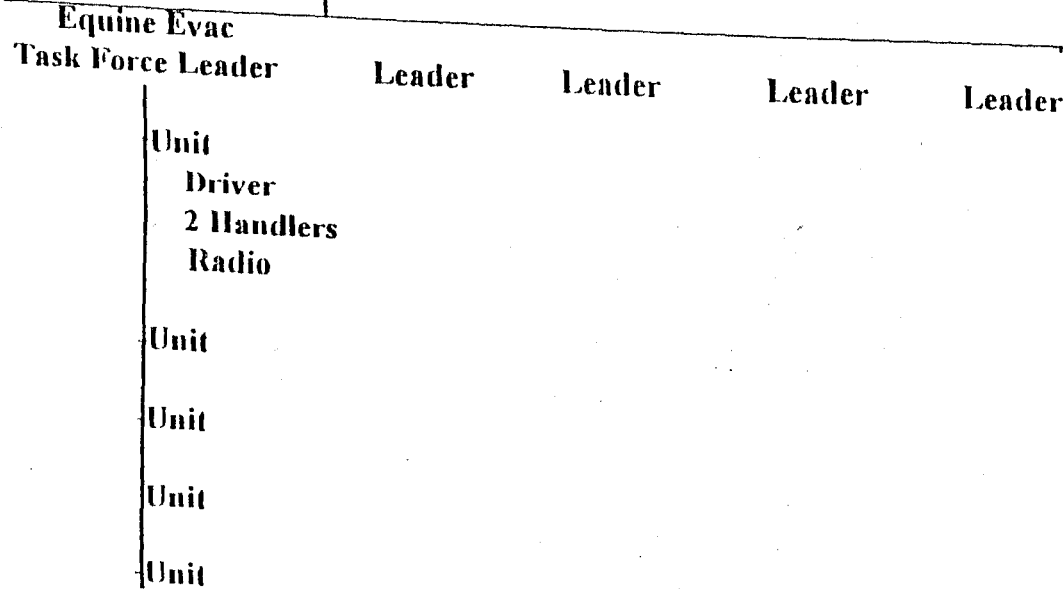

DUTIES

AGENCY REPRESENTATIVE:

Reports to the Liaison Officer and has the authority to make decisions on matters affecting Equine Evac at the incident. Will coordinate with Group Supervisor, Logistics, and Planning function for Equine Evac.

GROUP SUPERVISOR:

Reports to Incident Operations. Establish own Staging Area if necessary. Supervises Evac. Task Force Leaders

EQUINE EVAC TASK FORCE LEADER:

Will supervise units under his/her direction. May have to use own vehicle to check roads and driveways before committing units for evacuation.

STAGING:

Area for units to assemble and be directed for evacuation.

DUTIES

LOGISTICS:

Provides the support necessary for the Evac mission if not provided by the Responsible Agency or in concert with Responsible Agency.

Will provide shelters and staffing necessary to effect proper care, handling, recording and release of evacuated animals.

DUTIES
